RSL HOSTS XANGO CUP 2009 v. CLUB AMÉRICA:

Real Salt Lake (5-6-5, 20 pts. in MLS play) will enjoy its upcoming weekend off from MLS regular season play by hosting the fourth edition of the annual Xango Cup this Saturday, July 11, when Mexican side Club América will add itself to the distinguished list of opponents for RSL's annual exhibition showcase ... Kickoff for the first-ever international friendly at Sandy's Rio Tinto Stadium is set for 6:00 p.m. MT, with the Águilas' Utah debut airing live on KALL 700 Sports (coverage beginning with the America First Credit Union Pre-Match Report at 5:00 p.m.) and on a pair of Bustos Media stations – "Ke Buena" 1600-AM and "La Gran D" 102.3-FM ...

RSL v. THE WORLD: Saturday will mark an historic occasion for Real Salt Lake, which will be hosting its first-ever international friendly at its new Rio Tinto Stadium home ... The Xango Cup 2009 clash with Club América will mark RSL's 12th international exhibition in its now five-year history, with the squad posting a 5-4-2 mark (15 GF / 15 GA) in its previous 11 friendlies against competition spanning four continents ... Club América is the fourth Mexican opponent to visit Utah, joining Monarcas Morelia (2005), Club Santos Laguna and U.A.N.L. Tigres (both 2008) in facing RSL since the advent of MLS on the Wasatch Front ...

XANGO CUP HISTORY: Club América joins some of the planet's most revered clubs in facing Real Salt Lake in **XanGo Cup** action, as Spain's **Real Madrid** (2006); Argentina's **Boca Juniors** (2007); this month's MLS All-Star opponent and English FA Cup runners-up, **Everton FC** (2007); and Santos Laguna (2008) have previously blazed the trail to Salt Lake for the contest ... Real Salt Lake is **1-2-1 in the XanGo Cup series**, having dropped the first contest against Real Madrid by a 2-0 scoreline in August of 2006, gaining a 2-0 win over Everton and drawing Boca Juniors 1-1 in the 2007 doubleheader, and falling 4-1 to Santos last July ...

ALL ABOUT CLUB AMÉRICA: Officially named **Club de Fútbol América** (or C.F. América), Club América is based in Mexico City and owned by **Emilio Azcárraga**, who owns broadcasting corporation **Televisa**, making it the richest club in Mexico, and arguably the richest outside of Europe ... América and its rivals, Chivas de Guadalajara, share not only a long-standing rivalry, but the distinction of being the two most successful teams in the Mexican first division – América with its 10 championships sitting just behind Chivas and its 11 titles ... Club América has achieved more international glory than any other club from Mexico, and is tied with FC Barcelona (Spain) and FC Bayern Munich (Germany) for the number of official international titles, with eight ... América's team mascot, as well as their nickname, is the eagle or **Águila**; it is flown around its famed **Estadio Azteca** home stadium during halftime ... The Estadio Azteca in Mexico City holds the distinction of being the only stadium in history to host two World Cup finals (1970 and 1986) ...

Club América is managed by **Jesus "Chucho" Ramirez**, a former footballer who is the only coach to ever lead Mexico to title in a global FIFA competition, as he managed the *tricolores*' to the 2005 FIFA U-17 World Cup championship in Peru ... Ramirez was also named as manager of Mexico's senior National Team on an interim basis in March of 2008, leading the squad to a 4-1-0 record before the hiring Sven-Goran Erikson three months later ...

Club América's past rosters have boasted heroes of Mexican soccer such as **Hugo Sanchez**, **Cuauhtémoc Blanco**, and **Luis Hernandez**, while the current squad that will make the trip to Utah will be led by striker **Salvador Cabañas** and Mexican National Team stalwart **Pável Pardo** ... The 28-year old Cabañas is a prolific scorer that has played in the Mexican Primera since 2003 and been a member of Paraguay's National Team since 2004 ... The veteran Pardo, one of the most "capped" players in Mexico's history with 139 appearances on behalf of his country, has returned to the *Águilas* for a second stint after helping the squad to three titles during his seven-year run from 1999-2006 ...

CLUB AMÉRICA, ACROSS AMERICA!: Fans of Club América across the United States will be in luck across the next few weeks, as **Saturday's XanGo Cup** in Sandy will mark the first of five matches for the *Águilas* in the USA before month's end ... Following this weekend's affair against Real Salt Lake, Club América will travel across the Rocky Mountains to take on the **Colorado Rapids** on Wednesday, July 15 at Dick's Sporting Goods Park ... From there Club América will criss-cross the country to take part in the **2009 World Football Challenge** series of international friendlies, beginning with the competition's opener on Sunday, July 19, against Italy's **Inter Milan** at Stanford Stadium in Palo Alto, Calif. ... Three days later on July 22, the *Águilas* land in Atlanta to take on another giant of Italian soccer, **AC Milan**, at the Georgia Dome before heading to Arlington, Texas on Sunday, July 26, to take on **Chelsea FC** in what will mark only the second-ever event at the brand-new 100,000-seat Dallas Cowboy Stadium ... Club América began their preseason in earnest this past Wednesday, drawing fellow Primera Division side **Necaxa** 2-2 in a friendly played in Aguascalientes, Mexico, with Joaquin Martinez and Enrique Esqueda scoring for the *Águilas* ...

AMÉRICA SIGNS COLOMBIAN DEFENDER

AQUIVALDO MOSQUERA: Club América bolstered its defensive corps on Thursday with the announcement that the Mexico City club had signed Colombian international **Aquivaldo Mosquera** to a two-year contract ... Mosquera will be making his return to the Mexican Primera Division after playing two solid seasons with Spanish La Liga side **Sevilla FC**, this after he helped Mexican side **C.F. Pachuca** earn several pieces of hardware from 2005-2007, including the 2006 Clausura title, the prestigious Copa Libertadores crown in 2006, and the CONCACAF Champions Cup in 2007 ... The 28-year-old Mosquera has been a regular for Colombia during 2010 World Cup Qualifying action, even serving as the country's captain early in the competition ...

CLUB AMERICA'S OCHOA & RODRIGUEZ ALSO TAKING PART IN "COPA ORO":

Real Salt Lake won't be the only team missing players due to **CONCACAF Gold Cup** duty on Saturday, as Club America has lost first-choice goalkeeper **Guillermo Ochoa** and standout defender **Ismael Rodríguez** to the Mexican National Team for the duration of the regional championship ... Both Ochoa and Rodríguez have started and gone the full 90 minutes in the *Tricolores*' first two Group C contests, a 2-0 win over Nicaragua at the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum last Sunday and a wild 1-1 draw with Panama on Thursday at Houston's Reliant Stadium that featured three red cards – including one to Mexico Manager Javier Aguirre – and five yellow cards ... Mexico, currently second in Group C on 4 points, will close out pool play this Sunday, July 12, at the University of Phoenix Stadium in Glendale, Ariz., against surprise group leader Guadeloupe ...

REAL SALT LAKE V. CLUB AMERICA – SATURDAY, JULY 11, 2009 – 6:00 PM MT

CREW NEXT UP FOR RSL: Following this weekend's XanGo Cup clash with Club América, Real Salt Lake will return to its regular season slate with a tall order – a road contest at the red-hot **Columbus Crew** next Saturday, July 18 ... While RSL has good reason to be confident heading into the match, carrying a five-match undefeated streak and having brought points back from 3 of its last 4 road affairs, the defending MLS Cup champion Crew also seem to be getting their swagger back, going 5-1-6 since mid-April ... The Utah side contributed to The Crew's lackluster start to the '09 campaign on April 2, when FW **Robbie Findley** notched the first-ever hat trick in League play for RSL en route to a 4-1 triumph at Rio Tinto Stadium ... That result pushed Real Salt Lake's overall regular season record to 3-5-1 against The Crew, including a 1-3-0 mark at Columbus Crew Stadium in Ohio's capital city ...

RSL MIDFIELD TRIO PRIMED TO MOVE ON IN GOLD CUP: All three Real Salt Lake players taking part in the **2009 CONCACAF Gold Cup** – midfielders **Jean Alexandre (Haiti)**, **Kyle Beckerman (United States)**, and **Will Johnson (Canada)** – appear to be in good shape to advance into the knockout phase with their respective countries ...

Beckerman started play for the USA by going the full 90 minutes last Saturday in the Red, White & Blue's 4-0 drubbing of Grenada at Seattle's Qwest Field ... The Crofton, MD native then returned to his home area on Wednesday to take on Honduras at RFK Stadium in Washington, D.C., where he put forth another impressive 90 minutes in helping the U.S. to a 2-0 win over Honduras that clinched their passage into the quarterfinal round ...

Johnson has also started both games in the tournament for Canada, starting with a 70-minute performance in the Maple Leafs' opening 1-0 win over Jamaica at The Home Depot Center last Friday ... Johnson would get the start again this past Tuesday against El Salvador, this time going the distance in another 1-0 win for Canada that all but punched their ticket for the quarters ...

As a recently emerging option for Haiti, Alexandre might have been considered a surprise start in its opener last Saturday in Seattle, but the 22-year-old got the First nod for the *Grenadiers* in their 1-0 defeat to Honduras ...

Alexandre did not appear for Haiti in its 2-0 victory over group B minnows Grenada at RFK Stadium on Wednesday, perhaps resting up for the Haitians' do-or-die match-up with the United States this Saturday, July 11, at Gillette Stadium in Foxboro, Mass. (5:00 p.m. MT, live on Galavision) ... Johnson and his Canadian cohorts will close out Group A play this Friday, July 10, at Miami's FIU Stadium against Costa Rica (5:00 p.m., live on Galavision)

MOVSIKYAN SIGNS, BUT STAYS: Real Salt Lake FW **Yura Movsisyan** did anything but rest during the team's mini-break over the July 4th holiday, as the striker announced early this week that he has signed a pre-contract deal to become a member of Danish Superliga side **Randers FC** in January ... RSL GM **Garth Lagerwey** announced on Friday that the 21-year-old Movsisyan (4G/2A in 2009) will remain a member of Real Salt Lake for the duration of his MLS contract, which expires on January 1, 2010 ...

UNDEFEATED STREAK ON THE LINE: Real Salt Lake might not be wishing it had its current respite from regular season play, as the squad equaled the longest undefeated streak in club history last Friday with its 1-1 draw against the San Jose Earthquakes ... RSL will look to break the record when it travels to Columbus next Saturday, July 18 to take on the defending champion Crew ...

REWIND VS. SAN JOSE: Real Salt Lake didn't make it pretty, but it did manage to extend its undefeated streak to a club record tying five games on July 3 with a 1-1 draw against the **San Jose Earthquakes** ... After a choppy first half for both sides, the 'Quakes got on the board first, as FW **Arturo Alvarez** continued to plague the Utah side by scoring just past the hour mark ... Things got tougher for the home side in the 77th minute with the expulsion of FW **Fabian Espindola**, but RSL managed to keep the attacking pressure on, resulting in an own goal just into stoppage time off the foot of 'Quakes DF **Chris Leitch** that gave the Utahns a share of the spoils ...

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Since suffering its first-ever regular season loss at Rio Tinto Stadium on May 16 v. Kansas City, Real Salt Lake has gone undefeated in its last three matches at its new Sandy home, sandwiching 1-1 draws with Colorado (June 6) and San Jose (July 3) around a 3-0 win against Toronto FC (June 27) ... The Utah side now has a **4-1-3 home mark** (.688 winning percentage ranks 7th in MLS), **+11 home goal differential (19 GF/8 GA, 2nd in MLS)** and League-high **2.38 goals per home game** ... Real Salt Lake is trying to recapture last season's home form that carried it to the 2008 MLS Cup Playoffs, when the squad's 30 points, .733 winning percentage and +14 goal differential easily eclipsed the club's previous season highs at home ... RSL has dropped just 3 of its last 25 home games across all competitions dating back to the start of 2008:

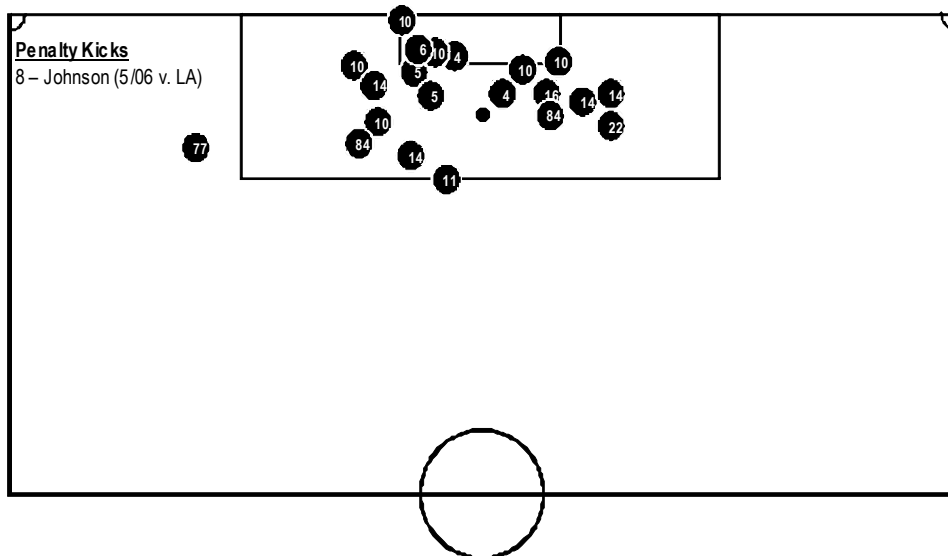
